Additionally, our *Sustainable Procurement Policy* and *Business Ethics Conduct* outlines the high ethical principles of our company. Ethical business conduct is implemented daily at DD Chemco because we are devoted to its importance in the workplace. Where required, our employees are supplied with safety equipment suitable for the work being completed.
